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hand corner.

At its most basic level, a stock chart is a visual representation of price and trading volume over time. Think back to your junior high math class when you plotted points on a graph. You had the x-

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axis and y-axis... On a stock chart, the x-axis represents time and runs left to right.

How to Read Stock Charts and Patterns: A Beginner's Guide

You can use a chart to see how a stock has performed in the past 5 minutes or 30 years. For price, the lowest price is near the x-axis, with the highest near the upper right-hand corner. Line charts also contain the name of the stock as well as its ticker symbol.

Stock charts may not tell you which stocks to buy, but they can help you decide whether it's a good time to buy or sell those stocks. When you know how to read a stock chart, you'll see things you otherwise wouldn't know about how other buyers and sellers have been trading that stock recently.

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
