Most notably, Staging the French Revolution calls into question some widely accepted truths about the cultural politics of the Revolutionary era. First, it challenges the traditional portrayal of the Le Chapelier bill of 1791 (which put an end to the privileges of the royally-protected theaters) as the very opposite of the Terror's cultural policy--the former freeing the theater, the latter enslaving it once more.
